WHAT IS YLM?

Youth Leadership Maury is a county-wide program for high schoolers designed to foster leadership skills, community development, and networking.

Class members will meet with local decision makers from multiple business sectors, including health, public service, government, and agriculture.

Participants will visit locations across the county, hear from influential speakers from the community. and participate in activities aimed to teach them about Maury County and how to positively impact where they live, learn, work, and play.

WH() CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any high school Junior in Maury County, whether they attend public, private, or are home-schooled, may apply for the program. Class members are accepted through an application process and spots are limited.

H()W TO APPLY?

Applications can be picked up from your school guidance counselor or at www.mauryalliance.com/youth-leadership. There is a \$100 tuition fee to participate in the program.
